DAY 1: KANSAI AIRPORT – NARA – KYOTO

Arrive at **Kansai International Airport between 6:00 - 7:00 AM**. After going through immigration procedures, your tour guide will welcome the group at the arrival gate. From there, board the **bus to Nara**. During the bus ride, breakfast will be served, featuring meat and egg sandwiches, fried chicken, vegetables, dessert, and juice..

Start your journey with a visit to the **ancient capital of Kyoto**. Begin at **Kiyomizudera Temple**, one of Kyoto's most renowned temples. Located on a hillside, this UNESCO World Heritage Site offers stunning panoramic views of the city. After exploring the temple, **wander down Ninenzaka**, a charming historic street lined with teahouses and traditional wooden shops. **Stop by Hokanji Temple** for a photo opportunity with the iconic five-story pagoda in the background. Continue your adventure with a visit to **Fushimi Inari Taisha Shrine**, known for its thousands of bright red torii gates that create a mesmerizing tunnel-like path.

Depart from **Kyoto and head to Nara**, where you will enjoy a delicious lunch featuring Japanese dishes, including the local specialty "**Yudofu**" at a local restaurant.

In Nara, **visit Nara Deer Park**, where you can enjoy the peaceful atmosphere and interact with the friendly deer. Next, **explore Todaiji Temple**, one of Japan's most famous and sacred temples, home to the largest Buddha statue in the country and a UNESCO World Heritage site. *(Please note that admission to Todaiji Temple is at your own expense.)*

Indulge in a hot and delicious dinner, offering a delightful culinary experience to conclude your exciting day of exploration.

DAY 2: AMANOHASHIDATE AND INE BAY CRUISE

Begin your journey at **Amanohashidate**, one of Japan's most scenic spots, often referred to as "**Kyoto by the Sea**". This stunning sandbar, covered with pine trees, stretches across **Miyazu Bay**, creating a picturesque landscape.

Next, embark on an **Ine Bay Cruise** to explore the charming coastal village of Ine, famous for its unique **funaya** (boat houses), and **feeding seagulls**. These traditional houses, built right on the water's edge, have boat garages on the first floor and living spaces above. The cruise offers a fascinating glimpse into the daily lives of the locals and the picturesque beauty of Ine Bay.

After the cruise, take a **stroll through the village** to get a closer look at the funaya and learn about their history and cultural significance. The serene atmosphere and the scenic beauty of the bay make it a truly enchanting experience.

Conclude your trip with a **delightful seasonal fruit-picking** experience in the countryside around Amanohashidate and Ine. Depending on the season, you can **enjoy picking strawberries, grapes, pears, or other fresh fruits**. Savor the sweetness of the fruits and take some home as a delicious souvenir of your journey.

Get ready for an amazing and exclusive trip to a **local winery**!

The **local farmers** are dedicated to crafting wine with their own **unique style**, combining the elements of wine and sake to create an **exclusive, authentic, and original wine**. This wine is made especially from grapes harvested from their **own vineyard**, making it a **100% made-in-Japan product**.

The trip includes a visit to **the winery**, an exploration of **the vineyard**, a **stroll through a genuine retro town** from the Meiji era, and a visit to a small but **gorgeous temple completely hidden from tourists**. You'll hear **the history of their wine-making** process and enjoy a **delicious lunch with tastings of various wines**. Please make sure you don't get too drunk! (^_^) .

Note: If you can't drink alcohol, you can choose grape juice instead.

After the trip, return to Osaka. Visit to **Osaka Castle Park**. Stroll through the beautiful park grounds and admire the exterior of Osaka Castle. *Please note that this itinerary does not include entry into the Tenshukaku (castle museum).*

Next, head to **Shinsaibashi-suji**, a bustling shopping arcade filled with a variety of stores ranging from high-end boutiques to quirky local shops. From Shinsaibashi, walk to **Dotonbori**, one of Osaka's most famous entertainment districts. Enjoy the vibrant atmosphere, neon lights, and the famous Glico Running Man sign.
